FULL-TIME PROGRAM

OVERVIEW

Every student attending GLA will undergo a full week of screening and assessments to allow David and his team of coaches to create a personal development plan and complete short and long-term goal setting. Regular reports will be generated to track progress and keep parents and college recruiters involved.

GLA will offer instruction and monitored practice each week, combining individual technical instruction plus group training, on-course play, tournament preparation, mental coaching, and a personal fitness program. GLA coaches will coordinate and accompany students to the top junior tournaments, as well as arrange college visits and placements.

A typical day will consist of academic work in the morning at Windermere Preparatory School, followed by lunch and transportation to the Academy for training. In keeping with David's holistic approach, every session will begin with a dynamic warmup before students begin either individual instruction or group training. Students will spend several hours on-course each week playing and simulating tournament situations on

the three golf courses available at Reunion Resort and Golf Club.

GLA has a dedicated sports psychologist, a mental performance coach, and fitness and biomechanics performance experts who will be offering regular assessments and support. David will provide his personal input and coaching to each student during the program.

In addition to holistic golf instruction, GLA will provide regular 'life skills' sessions with guest speakers that include professional tour players, college recruiters, sports performance experts, business professionals, and more.

Toward the end of each week, coaches will tailor the program to tournament preparation, including strategy sessions and equipment checks. In the evenings and spare time, students will be encouraged to maintain a balanced life with team outings to local PGA Tour and LPGA Tour events, visits to Orlando's famous theme parks as well as the pools, spa, and leisure facilities at the Reunion Resort.



GLA HOUSING

Boarding students will live in luxury townhouses in a gated community featuring a private pool, gym and clubhouse. Each of the spacious, warmly furnished houses is gender-specific and located within walking distance of GLA and both Reunion Golf Courses.

Students have access to common areas, TV rooms, quiet study spaces, laundry, kitchen and recreation areas. Great pride is taken in providing a safe, nurturing boarding environment and it is consistently expressed from residential families just how much the school feels like home.



Each house is under the care of full-time house parents who ensure the health, safety and happiness of the students. They closely monitor proper behavior, study habits and help to create a sense of community. Houseparents also work closely with parents, teachers and tutors to ensure each student is comfortable in class and feels happy and engaged at school.
